Word from the Pastor

On Oct. 9 there was a meeting of elders, deacons and anyone who is interested in the welfare and future of Lakeside. We had a wonderful turnout of 50 people with a great exchange of stories, ideas and experiences.

We also discovered that many people came to the church either by 1) invitation or 2) proximity. This is something that has not changed in the history of the church. People will at least visit a church when they are invited by someone they know. And while people will go relatively far distances to attend church, many people would still prefer to worship close to home.

Keeping these two things in mind the outcome of the meeting was a consensus that as a congregation we need to be more intentional in reaching out to the community around us. This can come in a wide-variety of ways. One way which has already begun is overhauling our website and keeping it current.

A simple check of a local real estate website showed that nearly 200 homes are for sale in the 33405 zip code alone. Is there a way to reach out to the new people moving into our neighborhood? How about the folks moving in on the island just across from us? Lake Clark?

As we see through history, life-styles and cultures are not stagnant. Church is not the center of family life any more, and it is not assumed that children will be raised in any faith. We live in rapidly changing times. While our message of Jesus Christ does not change, how we reach people is changing.

None of this is a small feat, especially for members and volunteers who have very full lives already. But one thing we agree on is our love for Lakeside and our belief that we have something good here to share. We're a warm, welcoming church. We are doing everything that we expect for a church to do.

While everyone should be praying for Lakeside and its ministry, we are all also ministers from Lakeside. How are you proclaiming the gospel of Jesus Christ? This is too good of news to keep to ourselves.

I propose that we start an Outreach Task Force or Committee that will specifically decide how Lakeside may reach out to others in different ways. Everyone at the meeting agreed we want to reach out to the community but then it requires people to do something. So will you serve? If you are willing to work on what is really the true mission of the church - bringing Christ to more people – please let me or a serving elder know.

# **Special Guest Speaker**



Carol Haeussner, member of the Iraq Partnership Network of PC/USA, will be coming to Lakeside on November 13 to speak on the topic, "What is the Presbyterian Church doing in Iraq?" Carol's parents were Christian missionaries in Irag for 30 years. She lived in the northern Iragi city of Kirkuk where her father started the first Protestant church in 1930. Following the fall of Saddam Hussein, Carol was able contact that church again. It is now the most active Presbyterian Church in Iraq.During her presentation, Carol will show photographs and speak about the Kirkuk Presbyterian Church, and the Kirkuk Church Kindergarten and Child Care Center which was started in 2004. The church is now starting to develop a Primary School. In July, 2014, ISIS invaded the northern city of Mosul and all Christians had to flee or be executed. Seventy of Christians fled to Kirkuk and are now living in Kirkuk Presbyterian Church. This is an inspiring story of a successful mission that was started 86 years ago. This church has survived monarchy, revolution, dictatorship and war and still exists today as a positive Christian influence in the Muslim world in Iraq.

# **Pastor Nominating Committee**



The Pastor Nominating Committee is diligently working to find Lakeside's next pastor. After a year of looking at candidates, we have gone back to the drawing board and are looking at a new list of possible matches. The way this works is that last year we created a Ministry Information Form describing Lakeside based on information given by the congregation at a series of meetings. Pastors also write their qualifications in a document called a Pastor Information Form. We are matched with possible pastor candidates for us to consider. The new match has given us 55 possible matches for 2016-17.

We are also applying for a Coral Gables grant from the Presbytery that will enable us to pay for a full-time pastor (Pastor Beverly is only 3/4 time) for 3 years. If we are awarded the grant, we will amend out MIF and expand our search. With a much broader spectrum of pastors, we will be more likely to find the "match" that God has already chosen to lead Lakeside Presbyterian Church into our future. The grant will only assist us for 3 years so our challenge at Lakeside will be to find the resources to continue funding the new pastor beyond those 3 years or we will be right back where we are right now.

Please keep Lakeside and the PNC in your prayers as we move forward. God has chosen the pastor for us but we have to be patient and listen to His Will.
